## Grasshopper Complex

In Numbers 13:17-20, Moses sent the 12 spies into the land of Canaan with two simple objectives: 1) See what the land is like. 2) Bring back some of its fruit. In seeing what the land was like, he offered some specifications. For example, he asked the 12 leaders to see if the people of Canaan were strong or weak, if they were few or many and if the land was good. He also asked them to take a look at the cities and see if they were well fortified or if they were not. In noticing the two objectives, keep in mind that he did not tell them to come back and report on whether or not the people should enter – that decision had already been made. God had long ago promised to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob their descendants would have the land. God always keeps His promises!

The spies came back with "Grasshopper Complex." In Numbers 13:33, how did they see themselves? They looked and saw themselves as small compared with everyone else. They saw themselves as weak and little and they lost confidence. God led them every step of the way, He gave them victory after victory. The mighty Egyptians had been defeated without a single sword raised or the loss of a single Israelite life. God had taken care of every need, but now at the door of the Promised Land, they failed to rely on the power of God.

There are times when God's people today fail to rely on the power of God and suffer from "Grasshopper Complex." We don't seek to do great things to bring glory to ourselves, but we can do great things as a result of God's power. God is faithful and has promised to be with us (1 Corinthians 10:13; Hebrews 13:5). God has delivered to us His will – what a shame to never study His precious promises (Romans 1:16; 2 Timothy 2:15). God has promised to hear our prayers (Hebrews 4:16; James 4:8) – let's make sure we take advantage of that promise. God has promised a crown to the faithful, to those who overcome, and with His strength is it entirely possible – "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me," (Philippians 4:13).

Let's strive to be like Caleb, one who embraced God's strength. It was Caleb who stood to quiet the crowds (Numbers 13:30). He displayed a great sense of confidence in God and in His strength. This confidence never waned and 40 years later at the age of 85 do you remember his words? "Give me that mountain!" What mountain was it? (Joshua 14:13-15)

It was Hebron, formally known as Kirjath Arba. Arba was the greatest among the Anakim. Who were the Anakim? They were the giants – he took the mountain from the giants at the age of 85. Let us know that with God and His strength, all things are possible!
