They Had Been With Jesus

The second miracle in the book of Acts is like all other miracles – quite remarkable. Of course, the first miracle was performed when twelve uneducated Galileans stood before a great multitude and spoke in all languages present in the temple, that unprecedented Lord's Day when His church was established (Acts 2:5-11). The second miracle recorded by the inspired Luke is given in Acts 3. Peter and John healed a man who had been lame from his mother's womb and was at the time of his healing, over 40 years old (Acts 4:22). It is a sentence, however, from the pen of inspiration that needs attention. Luke records these words from the thoughts of the Jewish authorities who had Peter and John arrested, "...they realized that they had been with Jesus," (Acts 4:13). Indeed, Peter and John had been with Jesus! In fact, they had been with Jesus from the beginning of His ministry and on three occasions they, along with John's brother, James, had been alone with Jesus. Notice two of these occasions with me. What had being with Jesus shown them?

The Raising of Jarius' Daughter – Mark 5:21-43

The girl was twelve years old, and as she was on her death bed, her loving father ran to find her Savior – Jesus. Even after learning the girl was dead, Jesus went to her home and took with Him only Peter, John, and James. What did they see from being with Jesus?

- * **Compassion** – simply put – Jesus went with him (5:24). The Lord was busy and had many things to occupy His time, but He never failed to show compassion. Jesus went with Jarius and showed compassion to him and to his family. Jesus cared. Do people in our lives see His example living out in our compassion?
- * **Power to help** – "Little girl, I say to you, arise." Jesus spoke only two words in Aramaic, but demonstrated power that only God can give. Peter and John would let the people around them know that by the power of Jesus Christ that lame man was able to walk (Acts 4:10). How powerful is the God you serve?
- * **Willingness to be ridiculed** – There was a large crowd in that home and all were weeping and wailing. When Jesus told them that she was not dead but sleeping, they all turned on Him. The Giver of life was willing to be ridiculed for the greater cause. Jesus would suffer ultimate humiliation on the cross, but would endure for man's salvation. Are we willing to stand for the greater good even if it brings some verbal persecution?

The Mount of Transfiguration – Matthew 17:1-9

- * **Majesty** – The face of Jesus shone like the sun and His clothes became as white as the light. These three men were with Jesus and saw Him in a body that no one else on this earth was ever privileged to see. Do you think that made an impact?

This scene would not depart from their memory. Peter was still making reference to it in the final letter from his pen – 2 Peter 1:16-18. One day, the faithful are promised an opportunity to see and wear the spiritual body – 1 Corinthians 15:49.

- * **Deity** – A voice was heard from heaven, "This is My beloved Son..." It is a confirmation from heaven of the deity of Jesus. Jesus Christ is the Son of God. The Word of God came and put on flesh (John 1:1-14). Peter and John knew and preached Jesus as God – may we never fail to do the same!
- * **Authority** – "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased. Hear Him!" The Father removed all doubt as to who possessed all authority. It is not in the Old Law or Prophets, but in Jesus Christ. Why would any turn to man and his religion? Let us always seek Him who has all authority! (Matthew 28:18; Colossians 3:17).

The third occasion the three apostles of Jesus were alone with Him was in the Garden of Gethsemane. We can look together at what they learned from the Lord on that occasion another time. Please give thought to what being with Jesus would teach them and of what it reminds us about Him still today. As you study these events in the life of the Lord, can those around see that you have been with Jesus?
